

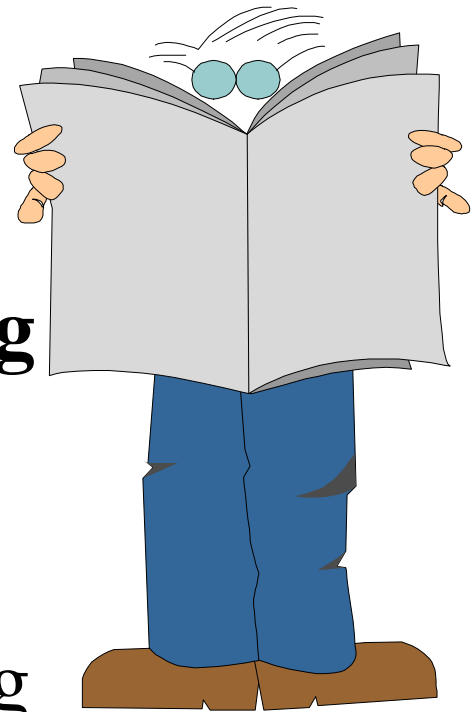

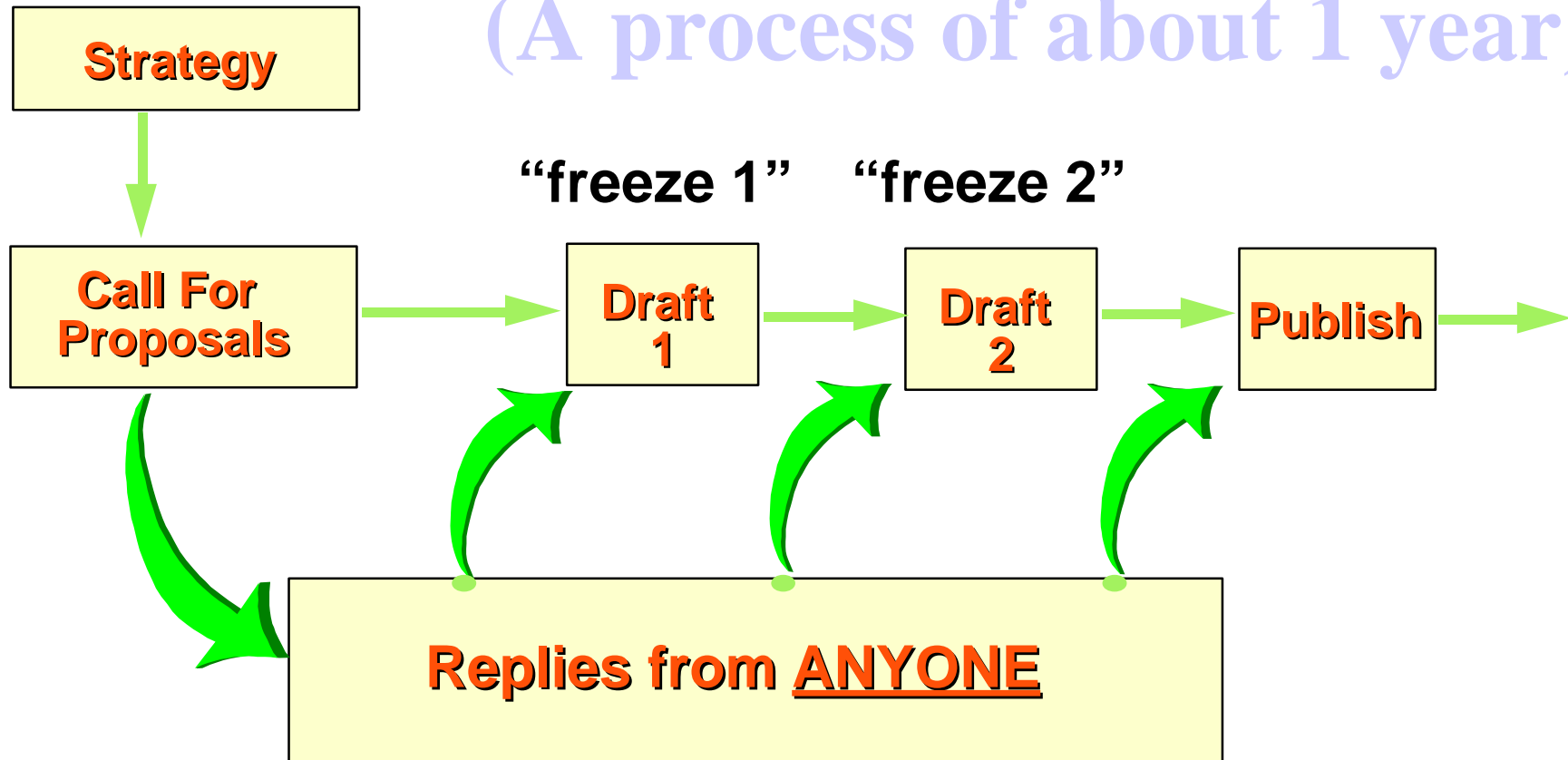

(A process of about 1 year)



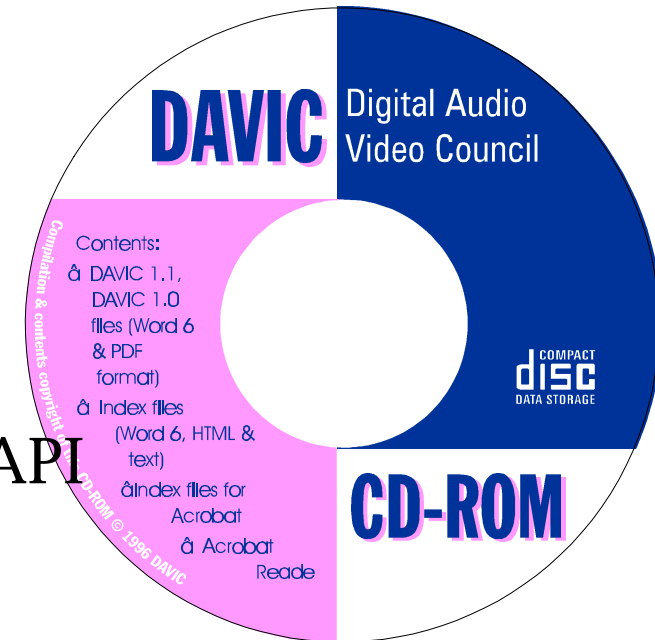

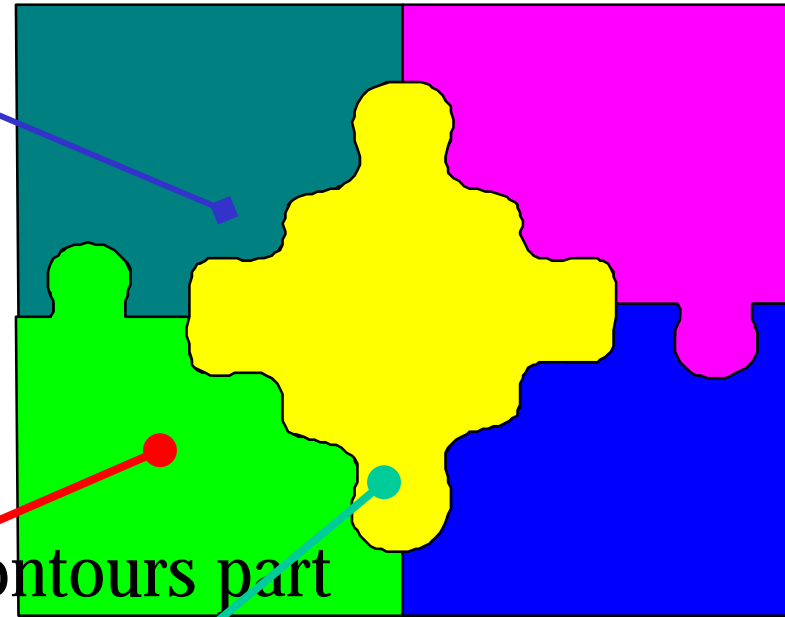
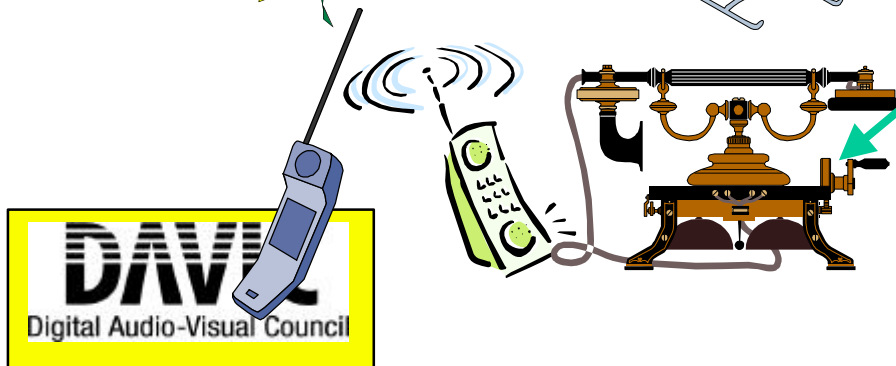
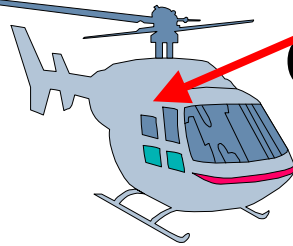
# *Planned new Specifications Structure*

# DAVIC PAS objectives

- **DAVIC values its ISO/IEC JTC 1 PAS Submitter status**
  - **as an important mark of recognition for DAVIC's open processes.**
  - **as an important means to help meet the goal of worldwide end-to-end interoperability.**
- **The adoption of the DAVIC PAS by ISO/IEC JTC 1 will help to consolidate the same technical solutions in each region by gaining international recognition and acceptance for the specification.**
- **DAVIC continues to build specifications as far as practicable on existing and developing standards and is committed to introducing its specifications into the formal standards process**



# DAVIC PAS Transposition Process

- Presentation to JTC 1 Plenary, Sendai June 2nd 1998
- DAVIC finalised documentation in mi-june 1998
- DAVIC recommend assigning the documents to JTC 1 SC29
- 6 Month JTC 1 Ballot on DISs and DTR
- Ballot Resolution and resolution meeting in 04/99
- Standard accepted (DIS 16500 Parts 1-9 and DTR 16501) and published
